History: This scholarship honors Jack Quinn who was a co-founder of the theatre company, formerly known as Valley Musical Comedy Company and Valley Theater Company. Jack directed and performed in company productions and served in a number of different positions within the company. He loved Theatre and was beloved by those with whom he worked.

What: Princess Theatre offers a \$750 scholarship to a student who is committed to long-term involvement in Theatre in any of the following areas: acting, producing, directing, designing, building, crewing, playing music, and conducting instrumentalists and/or vocalists.

Who: Application is open to anyone with Theatre education and/or experience who plans to pursue future Theatre involvement. Award preference may be given to individuals who have worked with Princess Theatre and those pursuing a major or minor in Theatre.

 - Career goals
 - School organizations and positions
 - Community organizations and positions
- *Fine Arts Resume* in a format similar to the one attached which documents Theatre-related experience. Be sure to include all Princess Theatre experience including on stage, as a production staff member, as a musician, and as a house volunteer. - *Official high school transcript*
- *Performing arts reference letter* which includes information regarding the applicant's *character*
- A 500 or less word statement about how Theatre has impacted the applicant's life and their plans for staying engaged in Theatre Arts in the future including pursuing a Theatre major or minor.
