Jack directed and performed in company productions and served in a number of different positions within the company. He loved Theatre and was beloved by those with whom he worked.

What: Princess Theatre offers a \$750 scholarship to a student who is committed to long-term involvement in Theatre in any of the following areas: acting, producing, directing, designing, building, crewing, playing music, and conducting instrumentalists and/or vocalists.

Who: Application is open to anyone with Theatre education and/or experience who plans to pursue future Theatre involvement. Award preference may be given to individuals who have worked with Princess Theatre and those pursuing a major or minor in Theatre.

- Fine Arts Resume in a format similar to the one attached which documents Theatre-related experience. - Official high school transcript
- Performing arts reference letter which includes information regarding the applicant's character
- A 500 or less word statement about how Theatre has impacted the applicant's life and their plans for staying engaged in Theatre Arts in the future including pursuing a Theatre major or minor.
